EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 82-14

TO APPROVE REGULATIONS OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS.

WHEREAS, the Adjutant General of the Territory, as administrative head of the Department of Military Affairs of the Government of Guam is authorized to issue and promulgate regulation in furtherance of the provisions of Title XXXVI of the Government Code of Guam; and

WHEREAS, such regulations require an Executive Order by the Governor to become effective; and

WHEREAS, the Adjutant General has issued the following regulation, copies of which have been provided to the Governor for review:


