**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2002-03**

**RELATIVE TO COMPENSATING EXEMPT POSITIONS  
ON A TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOUR WORK SCHEDULE  
BEYOND ONE HUNDRED SIX (106) HOURS WORK  
PERIOD IN THE GUAM FIRE DEPARTMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 2001-27 provided for overtime beyond 106 hours per work week for the firefighters in the Guam Fire Department; and


**WHEREAS**, the firefighters at the A.B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority are also firefighters; and

**WHEREAS**, inadvertently, reference to the firefighters at the airport were not mentioned in Executive Order No. 2001-27, where they should have been;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, CARL T.C. GUTIERREZ, I Maga'Lahen Guåhan, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do order:**

- 1. All non-exempt Firefighters to be compensated for overtime hours beyond 106-hour work week.** All non-exempt firefighters on a 24-hour work schedule in the GIAA – ARFF Division shall be compensated for all overtime hours worked beyond the 106 hours per work period.
- 2. Fire Captains, Fire Service Specialists, and Fire Battalion Chiefs to be compensated for overtime hours beyond 106-hour work week.** Fire Captains, Assistant Fire Chiefs, Fire Chief on a 24-hour work schedule in the GIAA – ARFF Division shall be compensated for all overtime hours worked beyond the 106 hours per work period.
- 3. Effective date and duration of executive order.** This executive order shall be effective October 17, 2001 and shall remain in effect until modified by law.
