EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2002-22

RELATIVE TO REDUCING THE NUMBER OF MEETINGS PER MONTH OF THE APPLICATION REVIEW COMMITTEE OF THE GUAM LAND USE COMMISSION/GUAM SEASHORE PROTECTION COMMISSION/GUAM NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD.

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 96-26 establishes guidelines for the Application Review Committee, and a set of procedures was outlined and adopted by that Executive Order.; and

WHEREAS, the guidelines mandate that Two (2) meetings per month must take place of the members of the Application Review Committee for the committee to do its work; and

WHEREAS, due to the shortage of manpower and resource limitations at this time, and also due to the fact that the Application Review Committee has voted to limit the number of applications per meeting to Five (5) to provide adequate review time for the member agencies, the number of meeting per month would be better served if the number were reduced to One (1) instead of Two (2);

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CARL T.C. GUTIERREZ, I Maga'Lahen Guåhan, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do order:

1. **Reduction of number of monthly meetings of the Application Review Committee of the Guam Land Use Commission/Guam Seashore Protection Commission/Guam Natural Resources Board.** The number of meetings required by the Application Review Committee of the Guam Land Use Commission/Guam Seashore Protection Commission/Guam Natural Resources Board as required by Executive Order No. 96-26 is reduced from Two (2) to One (1).
