**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2003-31**

**IN THE INTEREST OF PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH AND  
WELFARE RELATIVE TO MAINTAINING, PROCURING AND  
CONTINUING RADIO PHONES AND RADIO PHONE SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Organic Act of Guam vests upon the Governor of Guam supervision and control of all the departments, bureaus, agencies, and other instrumentalities of the executive branch of the government of Guam; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governor's duties to supervise and control the executive branch for the purpose of the proper execution of the laws includes the power of expenditure, *In re Request of Governor Carl T.C. Gutierrez*, 2002 Guam 1; and

**WHEREAS**, [t]he nature of . . . [the executive] office requires that the Governor have authority to use discretion in applying the energies of the executive branch and the resources of the . . . [state], as such resources are made available by the Legislature, to achieve the purpose or objectives of the laws, *Id.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the Legislature may not set limitations or conditions which "purport to reserve to the legislative powers of close supervision that are essentially executive in character," *Id.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the use of radio phones and radio phone services are critical to support the public health, safety and welfare needs of the people of Guam while also advancing our homeland security interests and defending the national security interests in the Western Pacific.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FELIX P. CAMACHO**, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, and the laws of Guam, to preserve the safety, health, and welfare of our Island of Guam, do hereby order

In the interest of public health, safety and welfare, all departments, bureaus, agencies and other instrumentalities of the executive branch of the government of Guam may use government of Guam funds to maintain, procure and continue the use of radio phones and radio phone services necessary to maintain and protect the public safety, health and welfare.
