EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2004-12

**RELATIVE TO EXTENDING OVERTIME IN RESPONSE TO THE
RECOVERY FROM TROPICAL STORM TINGTING**

WHEREAS, Executive Order 2004-11 declared a state of emergency in order to expedite the island-wide preparation and recovery from Tropical Storm TingTing; and

WHEREAS, the recovery effort from the damaging effects of Tropical Storm TingTing is still ongoing; and

WHEREAS, the authorized period of overtime has elapsed and overtime is necessary to expedite the recovery from Tropical Storm TingTing; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FELIX P. CAMACHO, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, and the laws of Guam, do order as follows:

This Executive Order shall authorize overtime from 8:00 a.m., June 30, 2004 until 5:00 p.m., July 5, 2004, unless further renewed by the Governor, in response to the recovery from Tropical Storm TingTing.

Any Executive Order heretofore promulgated in conflict herewith is hereby repealed insofar as any conflict is concerned.
