EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2004-13

RELATIVE TO AMENDING THE DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY TO INCLUDE OTHER AGENCIES OF SUPPORT IN ORDER TO EXPEDITE THE ISLAND-WIDE PREPARATION AND RECOVERY FROM TROPICAL STORM TINGTING

WHEREAS, as of June 26, 2004, the government of Guam was advised by the National Weather Service that Guam and the southern Mariana Islands have been placed on tropical storm watch; and

WHEREAS, as of June 27, 2004, the government of Guam was advised by the National Weather Service that Tropical Storm Tingting would be making its closest point of approach to Guam between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., Monday, June 28, 2004; and

WHEREAS, Governor Felix P. Camacho placed Guam in Condition of Readiness 3 and Emergency Operations Center at the Office of Civil Defense was established and Response Activity Coordinators (RAC) was activated as of 8:00 a.m., Sunday, June 27, 2004, in preparation for the potential damaging winds and rains from Tropical Storm Tingting; and

WHEREAS, Tropical Storm Tingting made its closest point of approach to Guam around 3:00 a.m., Monday, June 27, 2004; and

WHEREAS, Governor Felix P. Camacho and Lieutenant Governor Kaleo S. Moylan promulgated Executive Order No. 2004-11 which declared a state of emergency in order to expedite the island-wide preparation and recovery from Tropical Storm Tingting; and

WHEREAS, the support by government agencies in response to Tropical Storm Tingting included other government of Guam agencies not listed in Executive Order No. 2004-11.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FELIX P. CAMACHO, I Maga'lahaen Guåhan, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do order:

Executive Order No. 2004-11 is amended to include the Guam Power Authority, the Department of Administration, the General Services Agency, the Department of Education, the Department of Customs and Quarantine, the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority and the Department of Agriculture along with the Guam Fire Department, the Guam Police Department, the Guam Department of Public Works, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services, and the Guam Waterworks Authority as government of Guam support to provide such emergency services as are requested by the Department of Military Affairs.



Any Executive Order heretofore promulgated in conflict herewith is hereby repealed insofar as any conflict is concerned.
