EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2004- 16

RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING GOVERNMENT OF GUAM AGENCIES TO ACCRUE OVERTIME IN RESPONSE TO THE DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 2004-15 established the School Recovery Task Force ("SRTF") to ensure adequate facilities within the Department of Education ("DOE") schools by the start of 2004-2005 school year;

WHEREAS, SRTF assessed the condition of the DOE schools and identified the areas requiring immediate repairs;

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2004, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* declared that the DOE school facilities are in a state of emergency;

WHEREAS, government of Guam agencies are responding to the immediate repairs and maintenance of the DOE school facilities for the start of the 2004-2005 school year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FELIX P. CAMACHO, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do order:

- 1. Overtime.** This Executive Order shall authorize the government agencies responding to the Certificate of Emergency, dated July 23, 2004, and SRTF Working Plan to accrue overtime from 8:00 a.m., July 24, 2004 until 8:00 a.m., August 16, 2004, unless further renewed by *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*. This authorization for overtime shall also extend to bonafide executive, administrative, or professional capacity employees as defined in Executive Order No. 95-11.
- 2. Government of Guam Support.** Pursuant to EO 2004-15, all government departments, agencies, instrumentalities and other public entities shall provide such services as are requested by the SRTF.
