**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2005-05**

**RELATIVE TO AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2005-04  
CONCERNING STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR OFFICE OF THE  
ATTORNEY GENERAL OF GUAM TO CLARIFY THAT EMERGENCY  
PROCUREMENT INCLUDES ALL RELATED EXPENSES**

**WHEREAS**, Governor Felix P. Camacho signed Executive Order No. 2005-04 on February 24, 2005 to declare an emergency for the Office of the Attorney General, which must move out of the Judicial Center of Guam no later than March 1, 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 2005-04 transferred money to the Office of the Attorney General for rental of office space, but did not clarify that expenses related to moving will necessarily be incurred and also must be paid;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FELIX P. CAMACHO**, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do order that:

Executive Order No. 2005-04 is hereby amended to clarify that the emergency procurement authorized therein, and funds for emergency expenses transferred thereby, shall include procurement of any goods or services related to the emergency relocation of the Office of the Attorney General.
