



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2006- 06

RELATIVE TO RESTORING THE APPLICATION REVIEW COMMITTEE MEETINGS TO TWICE A MONTH

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 96-26 establishes guidelines for the Application Review Committee of the Guam Land Use Commission/Guam Seashore Protection Commission/Guam Natural Resources Board, and a set of procedures was outlined and adopted by that Executive Order; and

WHEREAS, those guidelines mandated that the Application Review Committee hold two (2) meetings per month to accomplish its work; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 2002-22 reduced the Application Review Committee meetings to one (1) per month based on a manpower shortage and resource limitations experienced by the government of Guam at that time; and

WHEREAS, conditions have changed to allow government of Guam agencies and departments to return to the twice-monthly meetings; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FELIX P. CAMACHO, *I Maga'Lahen Guahan*, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do order:

1. Executive Order No. 2002-22 is hereby RESCINDED.
2. The number of monthly meetings of the Application Review Committee of the Guam Land Use Commission/Guam Seashore Protection Commission/Guam Natural Resources Board is hereby restored to two (2) per month as required by Executive Order No. 96-26.
