EXECUTIVE ORDER

EMPLOYMENT OF CITIZENS OF GUAM ON FEDERAL CONTRACT WORK

WHEREAS, restrictive provisions relating to the employment of citizens or permanent residents of Guam by contractors to the United States on federal contract work were placed into effect by Executive Order 25-46 dated October 30, 1946 in an effort to protect the local labor source for purposes of rehabilitation work and other necessary local employment,


WHEREAS, rehabilitation and local employment has reached a status where it appears desirable in the public interest to relax provisions restrictive of such employment by contractors to the United States and permit such employment generally subject only to withholding of approval in cases where the public interest may require for necessary continuing rehabilitation and local employment or because of the character or circumstances of the proposed federal contract employment,

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of Guam I order:

1. Upon application to the Governor and a finding that the proposed federal contract employment is not contrary to the public interest in maintaining necessary continuing rehabilitation and local employment or because of the character or circumstances of the proposed federal contract employment, a contractor to the United States performing work on Guam may enter into a contract of employment with any citizen or permanent resident of Guam.

2. Executive Order 25-46 dated October 30, 1946 is revoked.
