Executive Order No. ~~4~~ - 49.

TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM

Subject: Revocation of Executive Order No. 23-47.

WHEREAS, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act provides for an Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and sets forth the function of that Board in detail, and,

WHEREAS, the Governor of Guam has appointed a Board to serve in accordance with the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, and,

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 23-47 of 8 September 1947 created a Liquor Control Advisory Board which functioned in the regulation and control of the use of intoxicating liquor, and,

WHEREAS, the function of the Liquor Control Advisory Board has now been fixed by law in a new and different Board,

NOW THEREFORE, Executive Order No. 23-47 is hereby revoked and the Liquor Control Advisory Board established thereunder shall cease to exist on this date.
