EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5-56

DESIGNATION OF FILING OFFICER PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 9500.4 AND 12007
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM

WHEREAS, Section 9500.4, Chapter 6, Title X, of the Government Code of Guam, requires that all rules and regulations under the Health and Sanitation Law shall be promulgated by the Governor by Executive Order and that the original of such Executive Order shall be filed with such officer of the Executive Branch as shall be designated by the Governor by Executive Order, which officer is referred to as the "Filing Officer," and

WHEREAS, Section 12007, Chapter 1, Title XIII, of the Government Code of Guam requires that all regulations under the Agricultural Law dealing with quarantine, pest control, fishing, slaughtering, dairy cattle and experimental dairy, and meat inspection shall be promulgated by the Governor by Executive Order and that the original of such Executive Order shall be filed with such officer of the Executive Branch as shall be designated by the Governor by Executive Order, which officer is referred to as the "Filing Officer," and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the Organic Act of Guam authorizes the Governor to assign to the Secretary of Guam additional duties to those prescribed by the Organic Act of Guam,

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the foregoing, I hereby designate the Secretary of Guam as the Filing Officer charged with the duties prescribed by Section 9500.4, Chapter 6, Title X, of the Government Code of Guam, and Section 12007, Chapter 1, Title XIII, of the Government Code of Guam.
