
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3-59

WHEREAS, Section 14101, Government Code of Guam, authorizes the Director of Commerce to make, alter, amend and repeal rules, regulations, fees and rates as required in the operation of the Commercial Port of Guam; and


WHEREAS, the aforesaid Section 14101, Government Code of Guam, provides that such rules, regulations, fees and rates shall have the force and effect of law after approval and promulgation by the Governor by executive order;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the foregoing, the attached amendment to the "Commercial Port Rates and Charges" is hereby approved and promulgated, and shall be in force and effect as of the 2nd day of January, 1959.

COMMERCIAL PORT RATES AND CHARGES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Director of Commerce by Section 14101, Government Code of Guam, the "Commercial Port Rates and Charges" as approved and promulgated July 27, 1955 by Executive Order No. 2-55 are hereby amended by adding new Sections, as follows:

Section 3.11. The rate for stevedoring services for empty metal drums not to exceed 55 gallons capacity is seventy-five cents (\$0.75) per measurement ton.

Section 8.8. The handling charge for empty metal drums not to exceed 55 gallons capacity is one dollar (\$1.00) per measurement ton.

The foregoing amendments shall be in effect as of January 2, 1959.
