EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20-60

GOVERNMENT HOUSING

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 4301, Chapter 4, Title V, Government Code of Guam, and Section 6(b) of the Organic Act of Guam, the following amendments to Executive Order No. 14-59 are hereby ordered:


1. Effective this date, paragraph (a) of Section 6 is amended to read:

"(a) There is hereby appointed a Government Housing Committee consisting of the Director, who shall be Chairman, the Secretary of Guam, the Director of Education, the Director of Labor and Personnel, and the Director of Medical Services. The function of the Committee shall be to prepare a charge schedule for the occupancy of government housing, which shall be subject to approval by the Governor. Such charges shall be issued by Government memorandum."


2. Effective February 1, 1961, paragraph (b) of Section 6 is amended to read:

"(b) In preparing the charge schedule, consideration shall be given to the type of construction, size, condition and location of individual units or types of units, the cost of maintenance and operation, and, where included, the cost of power and water. Where feasible, power and water may be charged separately, by meter consumption or otherwise. Where an individual unit is equipped with one or more air conditioners by the occupant, an extra charge will be made on a flat basis, except where the power so used is charged separately by meter consumption. Where meters are installed for individual units, government rates will be charged."
