EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 61- 12

REDUCTION OF OVERSEAS PAY DIFFERENTIAL

WHEREAS, Section 4110, Government Code of Guam, provides, in part:

"In the event it is necessary or desirable to recruit officers or employees for the government of Guam from the Continental United States or other territory of the United States, the Governor may, on all contracts executed after July 1, 1951, authorize an overseas pay differential of not to exceed twenty-five (25) per centum of the base rate of pay established for the position or for the class by this Chapter."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered as follows:


1. The overseas pay differential, where such differential is authorized, for employment contracts of initial recruitment executed by applicants on or after September 1, 1961, or any renewal of such contracts, shall be 20% of the base pay rate instead of the present 25%.

2. This reduction shall not apply to current employment contracts or employment contracts executed before September 1, 1961, or any renewal of such contracts.
