EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 61-15


WHEREAS, Section 12309, Government Code of Guam, in conjunction with Section 12007, Government Code of Guam, authorizes the Department of Agriculture, subject to the approval of the Director of Agriculture, to formulate regulations pertaining to the methods of taking fish and the equipment to be used therein; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Section 12007, Government Code of Guam, provides that such regulations shall be issued upon approval by the Governor and promulgation by executive order;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the foregoing, the attached "Amendments to Department of Agriculture Regulation No. 4, Relating to Fish Weirs, Location of Fish Weirs, and Procedure for Securing Fish Weir Permits" are hereby approved and promulgated this 18<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1961.
