
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 61-3

CONSOLIDATION OF OFFICE OF CIVIL DEFENSE WITH DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY


Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections 6(b) and 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. The Office of Civil Defense is hereby transferred to and consolidated with the Department of Public Safety. The separate status of the Office of Civil Defense is hereby abolished.
2. The Office of Civil Defense is hereby designated as a division within the Department of Public Safety, the head of which shall be the Deputy Director of Civil Defense who shall perform his duties under the immediate supervision of the Director of Public Safety.
3. The Director of Public Safety shall be responsible for the performance of all duties heretofore assigned to the Director of Civil Defense, and wherever such term is used in laws, orders, and regulations, it shall hereafter be taken to refer to the Director of Public Safety.
4. The Director of Labor and Personnel will effect the transfer of all personnel concerned from the Office of Civil Defense to the Department of Public Safety.
5. The Director of Finance will transfer the appropriation for the Office of Civil Defense for fiscal year 1961, including expenditures and obligations thereof prior to the date of this order, to the Department of Public Safety.
6. This order shall take effect this date.
