
COMMERCIAL PORT RATES AND CHARGES; CORRECTION

WHEREAS, Section 14101, Government Code of Guam, authorizes the Director of Commerce to make, alter, amend and repeal rules, regulations, fees and rates as required in the operation of the Commercial Port of Guam; and


WHEREAS, Section 14101, Government Code of Guam, provides that such rules, regulations, fees and rates shall have the force and effect of law after approval and promulgation by the Governor by executive order;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the foregoing, the attached order of the Director of Commerce correcting as indicated the "Commercial Port Rates and Charges" as heretofore approved and promulgated by Executive Order No. 10-60, is hereby approved and promulgated and shall be in force and effect as of August 22, 1960.

COMMERCIAL PORT RATES AND CHARGES; CORRECTION

WHEREAS, on August 22, 1960, as Director of Commerce I adopted the Commercial Port Rates and Charges that were put in effect on that date by order of the Governor pursuant to Executive Order No. 10-60; and

WHEREAS, such Commercial Port Rates and Charges, through inadvertence, failed to include a special rate for stevedoring services for containerized cargo and vans with cargo, so that as a result the higher rates provided by Section 3.1 would apply; and

WHEREAS, as indicated by the recommendation of the Commercial Port Committee, and the public hearing on the proposed Commercial Port Rates and Charges held on July 1, 1960, there was no intent to increase the rate for stevedoring services in this respect;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in the Director of Commerce by Section 14101, Government Code of Guam, the "Commercial Port Rates and Charges" as adopted by Executive Order No. 10-60, are hereby corrected to insert the following additional section, to be effective August 22, 1960, the effective date of Executive Order No. 10-60:

"Section 3.9. The rate for stevedoring services for containerized cargo and vans with cargo is two dollars and five cents (\$2.05) per as-freighted revenue ton."
