EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 63-4

GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE ON PROBLEMS OF THE AGING

WHEREAS, progress in medicine and in other sciences has been continually extending the span of human life; and


WHEREAS, as a result thereof, the number of our older citizens has been increasing and will continue to increase in the years to come; and

WHEREAS, plans and programs should be formulated so that the community might be enriched by the skills and specialized knowledge of this group; and


WHEREAS, studies should be made concerning the problems of the aging and the possible solutions thereof as well as consideration given to their place and function in our society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Manuel F. L. Guerrero, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby establish the Governor's Committee on Problems of the Aging to be composed of five members, one of whom I shall designate chairman. The committee shall be constituted for the aims and purposes aforesaid and shall meet at the call of the chairman.
