EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 63- 6

SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the school year 1962-1963 suffered several interruptions due to typhoons; and

WHEREAS, the damage to school property occasioned by Typhoon Karen necessitated reorganization of several school institutions as well as relocation of same; and

WHEREAS, due to the above described unforeseeable occurrences, all our children may not have received the high standard of education we seek to maintain; and

WHEREAS, it would therefore be desirable to establish a summer school program to aid those children who would choose to attend;


NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Acting Governor of Guam by the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. There is established a summer school program under the cognizance of the Territorial Board of Education. The Board is hereby authorized to implement this program and designate such curriculum as may be feasible and desirable.
2. To make this program as self-sustaining as possible, there is established a revolving fund known as the "Summer School Fund" which shall be under the cognizance of the Director of Finance and which shall be kept separate and apart from other funds of the Government of Guam and separate records and accounts maintained thereon.
3. The Board of Education is authorized to fix a reasonable registration fee for students which shall be deposited

in the Summer School Fund above established. Payments from said Fund shall be upon the certification of the Director of Education subject to the approval of the Director of Finance.

4. Should there be monies remaining in the Summer School Fund on the completion of the program, all such monies shall be transferred to the General Fund.
