AMENDMENTS TO REGULATIONS  
GOVERNING SCHOLARSHIPS AND STUDENT LOANS


WHEREAS, Section 11818, Government Code of Guam, authorizes the Board of Education to make regulations governing student loans, scholarships, and grants for transportation in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Section 11818, Government Code of Guam, provides that such regulations shall be subject to approval by the Governor, and shall be promulgated by Executive Order; and


WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 16-59 approved and promulgated Rules and Regulations Governing Scholarships and Student Loans;


AMENDMENTS TO REGULATIONS  
GOVERNING SCHOLARSHIPS AND STUDENT LOANS

The following provision of the Regulations Governing Scholarships and Student Loans adopted by the Board of Education on September 8, 1959, pursuant to Chapter 9, Title XII, Government Code of Guam, and approved and promulgated by Executive Order No. 16-59, has been amended by the Board of Education as of the date indicated, as follows:

Subsection 6.6:


"6.6 The Director of Finance shall prepare a monthly financial report concerning the Fund for submission to the Board, the Director and the Governor."  
(Amended April 20, 1963)
