EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 66-13

REGULATIONS AND LICENSES FOR HUNTING DEER

WHEREAS, Section 12321, Government Code of Guam, in conjunction with Section 12007, Government Code of Guam, authorizes the Department of Agriculture, subject to the approval of the Director of Agriculture, to formulate regulations to implement or carry out the purposes of Article I, Chapter 4, Title XIII, Government Code of Guam, dealing with Game and Fish; and


WHEREAS, Section 12321 authorizes the Director of Agriculture to regulate and license the hunting of deer and regulations are necessary to implement this activity; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Section 12007, Government Code of Guam, provides that such regulations shall be issued upon approval by the Governor and promulgation by executive orders;


NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the foregoing, it is ordered as follows:

1. Executive Order No. 66-6 is hereby repealed.
2. The attached Department of Agriculture Regulation No. 23, "Fall 1966 Regulations and License for Hunting Guam Deer," is hereby approved and promulgated, to be in effect this date.

REGULATION NO. 23

FALL 1966 REGULATIONS AND LICENSE
FOR
HUNTING GUAM DEER

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Director of Agriculture by Sections 12321 and 12007, Government Code of Guam, the following regulations relating to licensing and hunting of Guam Deer are hereby approved.

1. DEER HUNTING SEASON. The deer hunting season shall consist of two periods. During the first period, Saturday, November 26, through Friday, December 2, 1966, inclusively, it shall be lawful to take buck (male) deer only. During the second period, Saturday, December 3, through Sunday, December 25, 1966, inclusively, it shall be lawful to take a deer of either sex (male or female).

2. BAG LIMIT. Only one Guam Deer, Cervus mariannus, may be taken by a licensed hunter during this deer season.

3. EVIDENCE OF SEX. No person shall possess or transport any deer unless the antlers or sex organs are attached to and accompany such animal.

4. HUNTING LICENSE REQUIRED. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, kill, wound or shoot any deer on Guam without first obtaining a general hunting license from the Government of Guam, Department of Agriculture, or an authorized licensing agency.

5. HUNTING LICENSE FEE. FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00). This hunting license shall be valid during all the prescribed seasons of the calendar year for which issued.

6. DUPLICATE LICENSE. If a license becomes lost, destroyed or stolen the Director shall issue a duplicate license. The fee for a duplicate license shall be \$1.00.

7. LICENSE TO BE IN POSSESSION OF LICENSEE. Every person shall have on his person at the time of hunting deer a valid Guam hunting license.

8. ALTERING, BORROWING, LOANING OR TRANSFERRING LICENSE. No person shall at any time alter, change, borrow, loan or transfer to another, any hunting license issued in accordance with law.

9. LICENSE INSPECTION. The hunting license is subject at all times to inspection by any peace officer of the territory.

10. WHO MAY HUNT.

- a) Only persons 12 years of age or older may hunt deer.
- b) Persons 12 through 17 years of age must be accompanied by a licensed hunter 21 years of age or older.

11. LAWFUL HUNTING WEAPONS, PROJECTILES AND ATTACHMENTS. Deer shall not be hunted, pursued, taken, wounded, killed or shot with any firearm or device other than a shotgun or bow and arrow.

- a) No shotgun larger than a 10 gauge shall be used to hunt deer.
- b) Only No. 1, 0 and 00 buckshot or shotgun rifled slugs may be used for hunting deer.

c) No rifle, pistol or revolver of any caliber may be used to hunt deer or pigs during the authorized deer season.

12. USE OF DOGS IN HUNTING DEER PROHIBITED. No person shall make use of a dog in hunting, pursuing or killing deer, or for hunting, pursuing or killing wild pigs during the authorized open deer season.

13. LEGAL HUNTING TIME. It shall be legal to hunt for deer during the prescribed hunting season from one-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset.

14. HUNTING FROM A MOVING VEHICLE PROHIBITED. No person shall hunt, pursue, molest, catch, kill or destroy any game bird or game animal at any time from any automobile, power-propelled vehicle or other mechanical contrivance.

15. VILLAGES AND ROADS CLOSED TO DEER HUNTING. Firing any gun or bow and arrow within a village or within 100 yards thereof, or within 100 yards of an occupied dwelling, or on or across a public road is prohibited.

16. REPORTS. It is mandatory that the hunter killing a deer report the kill within five days after the close of the season to the Division of Fish and Wildlife, Department of Agriculture at 72766. This information will be used for future deer management.

17. VIOLATIONS. Violations of these regulations shall be punished as prescribed in Sections 12322 and 12323, Government Code of Guam.
