EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 67-8

CENTRALIZED AUTOMATIC DATA PROCESSING

WHEREAS, continuing management study indicates the value of centralized data processing, which conclusion is supported by reported experience of other jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the initial installation of an automatic data processing system in the Department of Education has provided a clear demonstration of its value in providing improved service to the Department, and to the Government as a whole; and

WHEREAS, it has been concluded that the existing installation can be most effectively utilized through a centralized system, which view is shared by the Department and Board of Education;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of Guam, it is ordered as follows:

1. The automatic data processing installation, with the exception of existing key punch operations, is hereby transferred from the Department of Education to the Bureau of Management Research, Office of the Governor.

2. All functions relative to automatic data processing will be performed through a centralized machine installation by the Bureau of Management Research, Office of the Governor.

3. The Directors of Education and Labor and Personnel will initiate necessary administrative transfer of the personnel involved.

This Executive Order is effective July 1, 1967.
