EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 68-15

EMERGENCY ATULAI NETTING REGULATIONS FOR INARAJAN
AND AGFAYAN BAYS


WHEREAS, Section 12007, Government Code of Guam, in conjunction with Section 12321, Government Code of Guam, authorizes the Department of Agriculture, subject to the approval of the Director of Agriculture, to formulate regulations pertaining to the methods of taking fish and the places where taking is permitted; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Section 12007, Government Code of Guam, provides that such regulations shall be issued upon approval of the Governor and promulgation by Executive Order;


NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the foregoing, it is ordered as follows:

1. The attached Department of Agriculture Regulation No. 30 Relating to Atulai Netting Regulations for Inarajan and Agfayan Bays is hereby approved and promulgated, to be in effect this date.

REGULATION NO. 30

EMERGENCY ATULAI NETTING REGULATIONS FOR INARAJAN
AND AGFAYAN BAYS

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Director of Agriculture by Section 12321, Title XIII, Chapter 4 of the Government Code of Guam, the following atulai fishing regulation for Inarajan and Agfayan Bays are hereby approved:

1. Netting for atulai in Inarajan and Agfayan Bays are prohibited; providing, however, that the group first secure a temporary net fishing permit from the Department of Agriculture.
 - a. Due to the community nature of the atulai fishing operation in the above mentioned bays and due to the desire to preserve this old Chamorro custom of sharing in the atulai catches with the community, the applications for the permits shall be coordinated through the Office of the Commissioner of the District of Inarajan.
2. Only one (1) permit shall be issued for each day.
3. Permits will be valid for one (1) day only.
4. Permittees will conduct their atulai net fishing operations in Inarajan and Agfayan Bays in the manner of the old Chamorro custom of allowing the community to participate and share in the catch.
5. Violations of these regulations shall be punished as prescribed in Sections 12322 and 12323, Government Code of Guam.
