EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 68-28

PARKS AND RECREATION RESOURCES-DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

WHEREAS, it is the Governor's duty under the Organic Act of Guam to examine the organization of the Executive Branch of the government and determine and carry out changes as are necessary to promote effective management and to execute faithfully the purposes of the Act and the laws of Guam; and


WHEREAS, studies conducted of the present structure of the Government of Guam show that transferring parks and grounds functions from the Department of Land Management to the Department of Commerce would create better coordination and efficiency;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections 6(b) and 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. The Parks and Grounds Division of the Department of Land Management is hereby transferred to the Department of Commerce.
2. The Director of Administration will effect the transfer of personnel concerned from the Department of Land Management to the Department of Commerce.
3. The Director of Administration will transfer those portions of the appropriations to the Department of Land Management for fiscal year 1969 which have been allocated for the Parks and Grounds Division, including expenditures and obligations thereof prior to the date of this Order, to the Department of Commerce.
4. Executive Order No. 66-17, dated September 20, 1966 is hereby repealed, and all other Executive Orders in conflict herewith, heretofore issued, are hereby repealed insofar as any conflict or inconsistency is concerned.

5. This Order shall be effective December 1, 1968.
