EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 68-7

REDESIGNATION OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Executive Order 65-7 was promulgated May 28, 1965, creating the Economic Opportunity Commission and designating said Commission as the Community Action Agency in Guam to carry out the programs authorized by the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, Public Law 88-452; and


WHEREAS, the 1967 amendments to the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, Public Law 90-222, requires the redesignation of any Community Action Agency after public hearing; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing hereon was held April 16, 1968, after appropriate public notice;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Manuel F. L. Guerrero, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, hereby order as follows:

1. That the Economic Opportunity Commission is hereby redesignated as the Community Action Agency for the territory of Guam;
2. That the Commission shall have all the powers enumerated in Section 212 of Public Law 90-222;
3. That Executive Order 65-7, except as modified herein, shall continue in full force and effect.
