EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 69-10

GUAM DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME

WHEREAS, Section 223, Government Code of Guam, established a standard time for Guam, known as Guam Standard Time, and;

WHEREAS, such section further provides that the Governor may provide by Executive Order that Guam Standard Time shall be advanced not more than one (1) hour;


WHEREAS, the military has requested, for military purposes, that Guam Standard Time be advanced one (1) hour from the time of the 150th meridian of longitude east from Greenwich;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Manuel F. L. Guerrero, Governor of Guam, hereby direct that at 2 o'clock ante meridian on June 22, 1969, Guam Standard Time shall be advanced one (1) hour from the time of the 150th meridian of longitude east from Greenwich, and that such time as so advanced shall be known as Guam Daylight Saving Time and shall continue in effect until 2 o'clock ante meridian on August 31, 1969, when Guam Daylight Time shall be retarded one (1) hour from the time of the 150th meridian of longitude east from Greenwich, and that such time as so retarded shall be known as Guam Standard Time and shall continue in effect until otherwise provided.
