EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 69-13

TRANSFER OF SECURITY SECTION ASSIGNED TO THE
COMMERCIAL PORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
SAFETY TO THE COMMERCIAL PORT OF GUAM

WHEREAS, the Government of Guam must continually endeavor to
reduce spending in the performance of services to the people; and

WHEREAS, the Security service of the Commercial Port of Guam
can be more economically handled by said Agency; and

WHEREAS, the transfer of the security responsibility from the
Department of Public Safety to the Commercial Port of Guam would result
in the reduction of security personnel from 17 to 7, the maximum number
needed to effectively perform security functions at the latter agency; and

WHEREAS, ten security personnel now assigned to the Commercial
Port of Guam can remain within the Department of Public Safety and be
reassigned police or fire duties and responsibilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections
6(b) and 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered as follows:


1. The Security Section (Commercial Port) of the Department of
Public Safety is hereby transferred to the Commercial Port of Guam.

2. The Director of Administration will effect the transfer of
seven security personnel from the Department of Public Safety to the
Commercial Port of Guam.


3. Executive Order No. 65-4, dated April 26, 1965, is hereby
repealed, and all other Executive Orders in conflict herewith, heretofore
issued, are also repealed insofar as any conflict or inconsistency is
concerned.

4. This Order shall take effect this date.
