AMENDMENT OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 65-7
STAFFING - ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION


Pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, Section 11, E of the Administrative Plan of the Economic Opportunity Commission attached to Executive Order No. 65-7 shall, effective this date, be amended to read:

"Positions in the Economic Opportunity Commission for which contributions are requested are full time positions in the classified service with the exception of the Executive Director and the Deputy Director. The Governor shall appoint the Executive Director and the Deputy Director upon the recommendation of the Economic Opportunity Commission; and the Executive Director and the Deputy Director shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. The Executive Director shall serve as the Executive Secretary of the Commission."
