EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 69-29

GUAM AMERICAN REVOLUTION
BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Federal Law 89-941 established the American Revolution Bicentennial Commission to provide for the commemoration and observation of the two hundredth year anniversary of the American Revolution and for the coordination of local, state, national and international activities planned in connection with this historic event; and


WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that Guam join in this activity by forming a commission to provide a program of suitable and appropriate events so that we may participate to the fullest extent in this national celebration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam do order as follows:


1. There is hereby established the Guam American Revolution Bicentennial Commission to be composed of thirteen members whom I shall appoint. I shall designate one member as chairman and the commission shall meet for the aims aforesaid at the call of the chairman.

2. This Executive Order shall be effective this date.
