EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 70-30

END OF GUAM DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 70-10 established Guam Daylight Saving Time effective April 26, 1970; and

WHEREAS, the schools of the Territory of Guam shortly will go into their regular sessions; and

WHEREAS, it would be desirable to revert to Guam Standard Time to avoid the dangers associated with students proceeding to their schools in the dark;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 6(b) of the Organic Act of Guam and Section 223(b), Government Code of Guam, do hereby order:


1. That effective 2 o'clock ante meridian on Sunday, September 6, 1970, time shall be retarded one hour to the standard time of the one hundred fiftieth meridian of longitude east from Greenwich returning the Territory to Guam Standard Time.

2. Effective on the day and time set out in Section 1 hereof, Executive Order 70-10 shall be repealed.
