EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 70-8

REPEAL OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS 67-18 AND 69-9:
RECOGNITION OF UNION, COMMERCIAL PORT OF
GUAM--REFUSE COLLECTORS OF THE DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC WORKS


WHEREAS, Public Law 9-240, the Public Employee-Management Relations Act of Guam, provided the necessary procedures for the recognition of employees' organization as the exclusive bargaining agents for employee units; and

WHEREAS, the said Public Law 9-240 repealed as obsolete Section 4022, Government Code of Guam, which required recognition to be extended by a formal Executive Order; and


WHEREAS, two Executive Orders have been issued under that Section which are now superfluous;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby order that Executive Orders 67-18 and 69-9 are hereby repealed effective this date.
