EXECUTIVE ORDER 71-1

AMENDMENT OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 70-33

WHEREAS, Executive Order 70-33 established the Governor's Commission on Fair Trade Practices; and


WHEREAS, the commission was requested to complete its report by February 11, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the members of the commission have indicated the work they have been assigned will require a longer period to complete:


NOW, THEREFORE, I CARLOS G. CAMACHO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby amend paragraph 4 of Executive Order 70-33, to read as follows:

"4. The commission shall exist until June 30, 1971, and shall make its final report and recommendation to the Governor on or before that time."
