EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 71-17

OVERTIME COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, Section 4004, Government Code of Guam, requires that the Governor promulgate personnel rules and regulations by Executive Order subject to criteria established by Title V, Chapter 1, Government Code of Guam; and

WHEREAS, inequities relative to overtime compensation have resulted in hardship and administrative problems for GPA employees; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission, on July 28, 1971, approved an amendment to GPA's Personnel Rules & Regulations regarding overtime compensation policy; and

WHEREAS, Section 4007(a), Government Code of Guam, permits personnel regulations to "regulate the hours of work, and working conditions";

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, and by Section 4004, Government Code, the amended overtime compensation policy for GPA's Personnel Rules & Regulations is hereby promulgated and approved as a standard policy for the employees of the Guam Power Authority.


All prior rules, regulations, policies, memoranda or Executive Order in conflict with this order are hereby superseded.
