EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 71-27

NATIONAL FOUNDATION ON THE ARTS AND THE HUMANITIES ACT OF 1965

WHEREAS, Section 5(h) of Public Law 89-209 authorizes the Chairman of the Federal Council on the Arts and the Humanities and the National Council on the Arts to establish a program of grants-in-aid to assist the several States in developing projects and productions in the arts in order to furnish services to local communities; and


WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Administration to foster the development of local artistic talent; to provide opportunities for citizen appreciation and enjoyment of the arts through a broad distribution of Guam's artistic resources; to help sustain and develop existing programs in the arts; and to develop and enhance knowledge and understanding of the arts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 6(b) of the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby designate the University of Guam as the sole state agency to administer the appropriate sections of Public Law 89-209.


All prior rules, regulations, policies, memoranda or Executive Orders in conflict with this Order are hereby superseded.
