EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 71-7

DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH - GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

WHEREAS, studies of the present structure of the Government of Guam suggest that greater efficiency in operation could be obtained if a Division of Mental Health is established within Guam Memorial Hospital; and

WHEREAS, it is the Governor's duty under the Organic Act of Guam to evaluate the organization of the Executive Branch of the Government and to determine and effect such changes as are necessary to promote the most effective management in order to execute faithfully the purposes of the Act and the laws of Guam,

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 6 and 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered as follows:

- (1) The Mental Health Section of the Department of Public Health and Social Services is transferred to Guam Memorial Hospital.
- (2) The Director of Administration will effect the transfer of all personnel, supplies and equipment concerned from the Department of Public Health and Social Services to the Division of Mental Health, Guam Memorial Hospital.
- (3) All executive orders in conflict therewith, heretofore issued, are hereby repealed insofar as any conflict or inconsistency is concerned.
- (4) Guam Memorial Hospital is hereby designated as the single state agency and Mental Health Authority to receive federal funds under the Mental Health Program.
