EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 71-8

GOVERNOR'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE
ON THE MAINTENANCE OF THE
PORTAINER CRANE

WHEREAS, the Government of Guam, by and through its autonomous instrumentality, the Commercial Port of Guam, has acquired title to and possession of a certain diesel Portainer crane from Pacific Far East Lines, Inc., said crane now being located at the Commercial Port of Guam; and

WHEREAS, a part of such purchase and sale agreement is that the Government of Guam shall assume the remaining portion of a certain service and maintenance contract currently in force between Pacific Far East Lines, Inc., and AMELCO, Inc., which calls for service and maintenance of the crane; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that an Advisory Committee on the Maintenance of the Portainer Crane be established in order to assure continuity of service and maintenance of such crane;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby order as follows:

1. There is hereby created a Governor's Advisory Committee on the Maintenance of the Portainer Crane.
2. The Committee shall have the power to inspect the crane, inspect the service and maintenance records of the crane, inventory spare crane parts, exercise periodic surveillance over actual service and maintenance of the crane, and possess and exercise all powers necessary and incidental to the implementation of those powers specifically enumerated herein.
3. The Committee shall be composed of the following:
a representative selected by each ocean freight carrier serving Guam on a regularly scheduled basis, the manager of the firm charged with the service and maintenance of the crane, and the Manager of the Commercial Port of Guam.

4. The Committee shall make written reports of its inspections, recommendations and other findings pertaining to the service and maintenance of the crane to the Director of the Commercial Port and the Governor of Guam for their further consideration and action.

5. This Order shall be effective March 19, 1971.

6. This Order is issued and promulgated at Agana, Guam, this 31th day of March, 1971.
