EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 72-24

PUBLIC EMPLOYEES MINIMUM WAGE ADJUSTMENT

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 70-29 authorized the recruitment of employees in positions at pay ranges 3, 4, and 5 above the minimum step in accordance with the provision of Section 2 of Public Law 10-172, approved on August 6, 1970, which provided that the minimum wage for government employees shall be no less than \$2.00 per hour; and


WHEREAS, Public Law 11-94, approved on October 20, 1971, increased employees' salaries by \$312 effective on the second pay period after the approval of the Governor, and by another \$312 to be effective July 1, 1972; and

WHEREAS, it is considered appropriate that, because of the two pay increases authorized by Public Law 11-94, all departments and agencies within the Government of Guam adopt revised methods and procedures for the implementation of Section 2 of Public Law 10-172;


NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered that implementation of Section 2 of Public Law 10-172 for Government of Guam employees shall be as follows:

- (1) The entrance rate for positions at pay range 3 shall be step 2.
- (2) The entrance rate for positions at pay ranges 4 and 5 shall be step 1.
- (3) The entrance rate for Substitute Teacher I and Substitute Teacher II shall be \$2.19 and \$2.25 per hour respectively.
- (4) Executive Order No. 70-29, dated August 31, 1970, is hereby repealed.
- (5) This Executive Order shall be effective July 1, 1972.
