EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 72-3

WHEREAS Title X Chapter IV, Vital Statistics, of the Government Code of Guam, establishes an Office of Vital Statistics within the Department of Public Health and Social Services; and

WHEREAS the Office of Vital Statistics is charged with the responsibility for the registration of birth, marriage, death and other vital statistic matters, designing the necessary forms for the systematic compilation of such data; and


WHEREAS the need for amplification of existent procedural standards for the preparation, filing, recording of statistical data has now evolved;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, the revised Rules and Regulations Governing Vital Statistics as attached hereto are hereby promulgated and approved as the standard policy for preparation, recording, compilation and control of vital statistical data involving marriage, birth, adoption, death and the issuance of certificates relating to such data.

All prior rules, regulations, policies, memoranda or Executive Orders in conflict with this Order are hereby superseded.

This Order shall be effective upon approval of the Governor.
