WHEREAS, good and sufficient reason dictates the inclusion of the Director of Commerce to the Manpower Planning Council,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam do hereby order and direct that:

Section 2 of Executive Order No. 74-13 be amended to include the following two members who shall represent the organization and interests specified:


Administrator, Guam Environmental Protection Agency
