EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 74-36

AUTHORITY TO RECEIVE FEDERAL AND PRIVATE FUNDS, ASSISTANCE, AND SERVICES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, UNIVERSITY OF GUAM

WHEREAS, American colleges and universities traditionally have the obligation and authority to seek and to receive from foundations, grants, and other aid funds in addition to their regular appropriated fund;

WHEREAS, the successful attempts among state colleges and universities for these outside funds have become most difficult and competitive;

WHEREAS, many funding institutions tend to look favorably on colleges and universities with appropriate autonomous discretion in matters relating to grants and aids;


WHEREAS, the University of Guam requires more institutional authority to make decisions in matters relating to seeking, receiving, and carrying out the intent or purposes for which grants and aids are awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor of Guam by virtue of the authority vested in him by the Organic Act of Guam and pursuant to Section 6107 of the Government Code of Guam does hereby order as follows:


1. The Board of Regents or its delegated authority is hereby directed to seek and to receive any outside assistance including assistance from the Federal Government in a manner not inconsistent with the laws of the Territory of Guam and those of the United States of America.

2. The Board of Regents or its delegated representative shall have the delegated authority, pursuant to Section 6107 of the Government Code of Guam, to enter into agreements with a person or persons in carrying out successfully the purposes for which the grant(s) was awarded.
