EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 74-4

REPEAL OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4-56
ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL LUNCH FUND

WHEREAS, the objective of the School Lunch Fund program is to reach needy children and provide for meals below cost; and

WHEREAS, the School Lunch Fund cannot be self-supporting with deficiencies occurring because of increases in pay, fringe benefits, the cost of commodities and the expansion of school enrollment with no possibility in the future of the Fund becoming self-supporting;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 6112 and Section 11110 of the Government Code do hereby order the following:

1. Effective July 1, 1974 Executive Order 4-56 is hereby repealed.
2. Thereafter, all cafeteria revenues and contributions from the Federal Government shall be deposited in the General Fund.
3. The Department of Education shall, in connection with its regular budget request for Fiscal Year 1975 and all budgets thereafter, submit an annual budget request for the School Lunch Program.
4. The Director of Education, after compliance with the Administrative Adjudication Act, is directed to establish a schedule of charges and to modify them from time to time to insure stability and


continued operation of the School Lunch Program within budget allowances.

5. This Executive Order shall be effective immediately.
