EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75-28

AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75-22:

MOST HONORED CITIZENS

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 72-22 dated May 20, 1975, relative to the presentation by the Governor of awards to Most Honored Citizens requires that the Governor present such awards on Labor Day of each year; and


WHEREAS, it is more suitable that the Governor be allowed to make the presentation of such awards at any time during a given year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do hereby order as follows:


Paragraph 3 of Executive Order No. 75-22 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3. The Governor shall request recommendations for these awards in order that he may be able to select and present them in a manner and by means befitting the occasion, at such time or times during each year as he deems appropriate;"
