
AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75-3  
AS AMENDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75-7

By virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam,  
as amended, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Executive Order No. 75-3, dated January 31, 1975, as  
amended by Executive Order No. 75-7, dated February 4, 1975,  
is hereby amended by adding a new Section 6 thereto:


"(6) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order, in  
emergency situations, travel authorizations may be issued and  
approved by the Administrator, Guam Memorial Hospital or  
the Director of Public Health and Social Services in connection  
with travel for patients and attendant escorts and/or persons  
required to be sent to the Communicable Disease Center in  
Atlanta, Georgia after the discovery of a possible case of a  
communicable disease. Within three (3) days after the  
issuance of the travel authorization a written report and  
justification shall be submitted to the Governor by the  
appointing authority."
