EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 76-14

AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 76-12

WHEREAS, one reason for Executive Order 76-12 was to protect the lives and property of the people of the Territory of Guam; and

WHEREAS, the intent of Executive Order 76-13 was to make as much daylight available to the people to pursue their efforts to recover from the catastrophe of Super Typhoon Pamela;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, Governor of the Territory of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws and the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do hereby order an amendment of Executive Order 76-12 to read as follows:

3. Effective immediately, no person shall be permitted in or upon the public streets, highways or any other public place, grounds or building between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. without a permit therefor from the Director of Public Safety.
