
CONTINUATION OF THE GUAM AMERICAN REVOLUTION BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION

WHEREAS, U.S. Public Law 93-179 authorized the President of the United States to continue the appropriate commemoration of events relating to the American Revolution until December 31, 1983;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby order that the Guam American Revolution Bicentennial Commission be extended throughout the Bicentennial Era and continue its functions as this Territory's official and independent agency relative to all Bicentennial commemoration of events until December 31, 1983.


This Executive Order supersedes all previous executive orders relating to the Guam American Revolution Bicentennial Commission.
