GUAM GAMING COMMISSION
GREYHOUND RACING RULES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, Section 59001, (4) of the Government Code of Guam (P.L. 13-26) authorizes the Guam Gaming Commission to make rules and regulations relative to greyhound racing; and


WHEREAS, the Guam Gaming Commission conducted a Public Hearing on 12 March 1979 to amend Sections 2.11 (2), 2.12 (2), 2.13 (3), and revise Rule No. 1.10 (12) and Rule Nos. 7, 11 and 12 of the "Six-Up Win Pool Type of Betting", promulgated by Executive orders Nos. 77-22 and 78-45; and

WHEREAS, The Guam Gaming Commission has adopted said amendments.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAUL M. CALVO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam as amended, do hereby approve and promulgate, as attached hereto, the amendments to the Guam Gaming Commission Greyhound Racing Rules and Regulations on Sections 2.11 (2), 2.12 (2) and 2.13 (3) and the revisions on Rule No. 1.10 (12) and Rule Nos. 7, 11 and 12 of the "Six-Up Win Pool Type of Betting".

This order shall be effective upon approval of the Governor and upon filing of said order with the Legislative Secretary of the Legislature.
