

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 80-6

LEAVE YEAR REDEFINED

WHEREAS, Public Law 14-132, enacted in June 30, 1978 amends the fiscal year of the Government of Guam from the period July 1 to June 30, to October 1 to September 30; and

WHEREAS, the Government of Guam Personnel Rules and Regulations, i.e. Rule 11.42 defines leave year as the period beginning July 1 to the beginning of the first complete pay period in the following fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, this rule is inconsistent with Public Law 14-132 and likewise affects the conversion of annual leave accrual at the end of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has opined that amendment to the provision of this rule need not go through the Administrative Adjudication Law since it does not affect members of the public.

NOW THEREFORE, I, PAUL M. CALVO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, and Section 4004 of the Government Code of Guam, do hereby amend Rule 11.42 of the Government of Guam Personnel Rules and Regulations promulgated by Executive Order No. 79-8, to redefine leave year as follows:


"Leave year means the period from the beginning of the first complete pay period in the fiscal year commencing October 1 to the beginning of the first complete pay period in the following fiscal year."
