EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 83-016

PERMITS FOR THE USE OF GOVERNMENT PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 6 of the Organic Act of Guam, the Governor is vested the authority to exercise general supervision and control over all departments, bureaus, agencies and other instrumentalities of the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 9 of the Organic Act of Guam, all officers of the Executive Branch shall have such powers and duties as may be conferred or imposed upon them by law or by executive regulation of the Governor not inconsistent with any law; and

WHEREAS, certain agencies authorized to issue permits for the use of Government real property, buildings and facilities, have engaged in activities contrary to applicable laws, rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, there have been instances where permits were granted for the use of government land, buildings and/or facilities in direct violation of pertinent laws, rules and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act and laws of Guam as Governor of the unincorporated territory of Guam, do hereby order that:


1. All departments and agencies, autonomous agencies and public corporations, duly authorized by law or executive order to issue permits for the use of government land, buildings and/or facilities, review all pertinent laws, rules and regulations relating to the issuance of permits.

2. All departments, agencies, autonomous agencies and public corporations duly authorized by law or executive order to issue permits, are prohibited from issuing permits authorizing the use of one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) acre or more of government real property, the use of government buildings and/or facilities, unless such permits are given prior approval by the Governor.


3. This Order shall not apply to the issuance of permits relating to the use of school buildings and/or facilities for educational and training purposes.

4. This Order shall be effective immediately.
