EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 87-22

AMENDMENT TO RULES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION  
OF CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS AND OTHER  
PLACES OF CONFINEMENT

**WHEREAS**, there currently exists a compelling need to reevaluate the Prisoner Work Release Program;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Corrections needs greater flexibility in the administration of the Prisoner Work Release Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Corrections is authorized by 9 Guam Code Annotated to make regulations governing the Prisoner Work Release Program subject to the approval of the Governor by Executive Order.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FRANK F. BLAS**, Acting Governor of Guam by virtue of the authority vest in me by the Organic Act of Guam and 9 Guam Code Annotated do hereby amend Section 4504 of Executive Order No. 72-21 to read:

Same: Authorized disciplinary actions. Whenever a client is found guilty of violating the rules, he may be subjected to one or more of the following disciplinary actions:

- (a) Action by the employee witnessing the violation:
  - (1) Counseling and/or warning.
  - (2) Reprimand.
  - (3) Temporary loss of one or more privileges.
  - (4) Confinement in isolation not to exceed five days, subject to the approval of the institutional head.

- (b) Actions by the Adjustment and Classification Committee.  
All of the above plus the following:
- (1) Reduction to the next lower step classification.
  - (2) Confinement in isolation not to exceed thirty days.
  - (3) Permanent loss of one or more privileges.
  - (4) Removal from the Prisoner Work Release Program.

Items one (1) through four (4), immediately above, are subject to the approval of the Director.
